70th Annual Meeting of the GMDS September 07-11, 2025 in Jena

These include long contributions (full paper: Stud HTI at IOS Press or MIBE), short contributions (abstracts, 500 words via eGMS Proceedings as lectures or posters), special formats such as workshops, panels, working group meetings, as well as other formats such as invited sessions or BarCamps. In addition, there will be "hands-on" tutorials offered on Sunday (09/07/2025).

Submission of contributions

The submission of contributions is done on the conference's "Submission Platform" ("Online Registry"). You can access it at

https://access.online-registry.net/gmds2025.

How to proceed:

- 1. Register on the platform or log in with your user ID and password.
- 2. Click on **Start Submission of Contributions**.
- 3. Select a suitable specialist area and topic.
- 4. Select the appropriate entry under Contribution Type. The following options are available:
 - a. Full paper Stud HTI
 - b. Full paper MIBE
 - c. Abstract (Oral presentation)
 - d. Abstract (Poster)
 - e. Special formats (including workshops, symposia, tutorials, commission meetings, BarCamps, invited sessions, etc.)
- 5. Fill in the mandatory field *Title* and select the *language*.
- 6. Upload the completed form under **File(s)**. Please note the templates for IOS Press and the form for special formats, which are specified in the online registry.
- Important: The abstract defines the text that will be published in the conference program. Please enter the text there.
- 8. Declare potential conflicts of interest and provide information on the ethics vote.
- 9. Click **Save Data** and **continue with Step 2** to proceed with the author entry.
- 10. After a final review in step 3, you can complete the submission.

The Medical Informatics Initiative Germany Satellite Symposium, which will take place on Thursday, September 11, 2025, at the Volkshaus, will be planned and submitted separately.

Information on the registration process for special formats

What are special formats?

Special formats include **tutorials (on Sunday)**, workshops, symposia, working group meetings, project groups, working groups, presidium commission and technical committee meetings, as well as workshops, discussion panels, invited sessions, BarCamps or other formats.

How does the review/approval process work?

Special formats will be reviewed by the respective GMDS section heads. The process will be kept lean to ensure quick feedback on acceptance.

How do I submit special formats?

Special formats are also registered via the online registry. The form for this can be downloaded and completed in the online registry (see also the section on **submission of contributions**).

Publication of the short description of the special formats via the eGMS platform is only possible in exceptional cases.

The deadline for submitting special formats is Friday, April 25, 2025.

Since the "hands-on" tutorials, which will take place on Sunday (September 7, 2025), will be advertised via the conference registration, their deadline is Monday, March 3, 2025 already.
